# IBARMS MYP Breakout Session Notes - Friday, January 20, 2012

#### Elections:

Elections for officers will occur at our next meeting. Nikki, our current MYP representative, may possibly be moving on to another school. If you are interested in running for her position, please notify Nikki's.

#### MYP Student Summit:

The date for the MYP Student Summit is April 19 at McAuliffe. Students will attend the opening keynote (Peruvian Hearts) and two additional sessions. The folks planning the summit are still looking for people to run student sessions. These need to be run by certificated teachers.

Additionally, vendors are needed for the student summit. The vendors should be able to talk with students. Vendors selling items are not what the committee is looking for.

### IB Conference of the Americas:

The IB Conference is coming up soon. There will be a drawing at the next IBARMS meeting for one person to attend (registration and travel paid by IBARMS). If you are interested in being a presenter at the conference, that is encouraged. Nikki has presented before, so she would be a good contact for information and advice.

### Round Tables:

The following were brought up as the biggest needs:

- Language B Bethany (Summit County) is willing to facilitate and Aurora Hills is willing to host. Ideally, the round table will be in April or May since the new guide should be published in March. If you haven't yet seen it, there is a draft extract available on the OCC.
