Assistant Principle and IB coordinator background

- Our program is to extend and support subject choice for students in IB World Schools.
- All profits go to McCall MacBain Foundation. Money helps fund needs in Africa.
 Pamoja was founded in 2009 and continues with course development.
- Currently has 356 students in year 2 if IB. 747 students in year 1; including 12
 Open World School. (Students from non-IB world schools are allowed to take IB
 online questions.) These students are not taking the full diploma. Pamoja does not
 offer the full diploma.
- Exams 2012 -4.44-77% pass rate
- Start Date Sept 4 end Date May 23rd. Year 2 ends in April due to May exams. Assignments are given on Wednesday and they are due the following Tuesday.
- All courses are 2 yrs SL and HL.
- Pamoja accepts students that have to transfer and the new IB school does not offer the course.
- Cost: They do have some scholarships. Some charge the students the whole cost.
 Some schools pay the tuition or share with the cost with parents.
 Last year cost was \$800 per student per year. Transfer students pay an extra fee.
- Price may be reduced by the school's free and reduced lunch.
- Students take a diagnostic quiz to test if they will be a good online student. Students need to login 4 times a week. It is recommended to schedule it into the students schedule.
- SBC Site Based Coordinator. Each school must have a trained teacher on site to monitor the students. Does not need to be a subject expert. Training 5-6 hours online.

- Enroll students via Pamoja Education.
- Pamoja will not put more than 5 from one school into one section.
- Students take exams with the school.
